Clarification for Q&A's

- If a pupil shows any COVID symptoms they are to be sent home and asked to contact TTP (see FCC Website <u>https://www.flintshire.gov.uk/en/Resident/Emergency-Planning/Test-</u><u>Trace-Protect.aspx</u> where is says "click here" or dial 119) to arrange a test. Any siblings in school should be sent home with them at this point as a precaution. The whole household will isolate at this point.
- If the test returns positive, any person who meets the criteria for TTP will be asked to remain at home in isolation for 14 days.
- If the test returns negative, the child/staff member can return to school when they are well to do so, unless any other member of their household has tested positive or is showing symptoms. If they are unsure around this they should contact their GP or a medical professional for advice.
- All negative test results must be forwarded to school, please, for their records and to ensure everyone's safety.
- If any individual is contacted by TTP and asked to isolate due to contact with a positive case, it is only that one individual in household who will need to isolate for the 14 days.
- If you are asked for any advice with regards to people isolating and being fit to return to school you should direct them to TTP or a medical professional.

Obviously with everything at the moment things can be subject to change, but this is based on the current guidance and feedback we are having directly from FCC to Flintshire schools.
