In relation to 'Key Worker' Status, please see definition below, released by Welsh Government today, Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March.

1:30pm still waiting for Welsh Government definition for 'Key Worker'.

This is FCC's definition - posted Thursday, 19th March 2020:

Medical professionals including doctors, nurses, midwives, paramedics etc.

Other health workers - such as employment in a medical/health setting

Community safety - police force and fire brigade

Education - teachers, classroom support staff, school cleaners/caretakers etc

Workers in childcare/early years settings

Social care/domiciliary care works

Council staff who will be involved in key roles e.g. streetscene operatives, drivers, school escorts, catering staff etc.

## \*\*\* PLEASE NOTE \*\*\*

With reference to our previous letter, Letter 10, posted on Gwenffrwd's website,  $20^{th}$  March – please follow the expectation and guidelines from FCC. This clearly states that any childcare provision, after  $20^{th}$  March, should be for homes where both parents are 'Key Workers', and those of single parent families where that parent is a 'Key Worker'.

As a Governing Body, we are collating information for FCC as the Local Authority is preparing a childcare service for 'Key Workers' within Flintshire. Things are changing by the minute, and we have been asked this afternoon, to prepare a service at Ysgol Gwenffrwd, from Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March onwards, between 8:00am and 5:30pm.

Obviously, this service is for 'Key Workers' (criteria described above) who are actually on work shift during that day e.g. if you are a 'Key Worker' and off duty until Thursday 26<sup>th</sup>

March, then you would care for your child at home until the day of your shift - <u>as we are all trying to abide by WG rules of lessening Social Contact</u>. We thank you, as parents, for abiding by these rules and restrictions. To be able to register children we will need all 'Key Worker' parents to fill in this form below and return to Ysgol Gwenffrwd - either printed out and handed in to the school office by yourselves when dropping off your child/children at Ysgol Gwenffrwd on Monday morning, or if you are not on shift until the end of the week, email it to <u>Gwenffrwd@hwbmail.net</u>, by 9am Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020. This is paramount, so that we can register your child.
