Dear Parents, Guardians and Families;

Gobeithio eich bod yn parhau i gadw'n iach. Pleser llwyr oedd gweld cymuned Ysgol Gwenffrwd yn y fidio Diolch i'r Gweithwyr Allweddol yr wythnos diwethaf- ac rwy'n diolch i Mrs Rule am ei sgiliau trefnu ac i'r plantos a'r staff am eu cyfraniadau gwerthfawr- y cwbwl yn codi calon. Diolch i chi gyd am eich cefnogaeth i'r dysgu ar-lein adref drwy Seesaw a Google Classrooms- rydym fel staff yn gwerthfawrogi hyn yn arw.

Wrth inni nesau at Hanner Tymor, hoffwn eich hysbysu NA fydd gwaith yn cael ei osod i'r plant wythnos Mai 25-29ain. Fodd bynnag, gofynnwn yn garedig i'r plant, gyda chefnogaeth eu teuluoedd, i wyliau 1-2 awr o raglenni Cymraeg S4C yn ystod yr hanner tymor o.g.y.dda. Mae ap 'Cyw tiwb' hefyd yn llawn raglenni Cymraeg i blant. Hoffwn dynnu eich sylw at y ffaith y BYDD Y CWIS TEULUOL dal ymlaen fel arfer nos Fercher Mai 27ain, Diolch.

Y Cwestiwn sydd ar wefusau pawb yw- Beth yw'r cam/au nesaf i'r ysgolion yng Nghymru, ac i Ysgol Gwenffrwd? Yr ateb syml yw- nid ydym yn gwbod eto, felly mae'n rhaid parhau i aros am ddatganiad yn amyneddgbar! Rydym fel Penaethiaid Sir y Fflint, wedi gofyn wrth Lywodraeth Cymru os yw'n bosib i Bl.6 yn unig ddychwelyd i'r ysgolion am ychydig amser cyn yr haf- oherwydd eu bod ar fîn cymeryd cam mawr yn eu taith addysgol, sef trosglwyddo i'r sector uwchradd. NID oes penderfyniad wedi ei wneud ar hyn eto. Rydym fel Penaethiaid, ac UDA yn gweithio ar faterion I&D/ Asesiadau Risg a y funud fel paratoad i'r cam nesaf- ond yn aros am gyfarwyddiadau gan Lywodraeth Cymru. Pan ddaw hyn, byddaf fi a Llywodraethwyr Gwenffrwd yn eich hysbysu fel rhieni, am gynlluniau Ysgol Gwenffrwd. Diolch yn fawr am eich cydweithrediad.

I hope that you are all still keeping well. It was a joy to see the school community in the *Diolch i'r Gweithwyr Allweddol/ Key Workers* video last week. I thank Mrs Rule for her organisational skills and all children and staff for their most valuable contributions- *Diolch yn fawr iawn*. Thank you also, as families, for your efforts with the home-learning through Seesaw and Google classrooms- it is much appreciated by us as staff.

As we are heading for Half-Term, I wish to inform you that there will be NO work set for pupils: Week May 25-29th. However, we are asking all pupils- with the support of families please, to watch 1-2 hours of S4C WELSH-Medium programmes during half-term week. We are fully aware that children do not watch as much live TV these days- but you can go to s4Clic or BBC i-Player on your device and go to the A-Z tab, to find the name of your Welsh-Medium programme e.g. *Patrôl Pawennau* (the Welsh Paw Patrol), *Octonauts* (Welsh Octonauts), *CYW*, *Deian a Loli*, *Stwnsh*, *Ffeil*, *Ynys Adre*, *Eisteddfod yr Urdd*, ayb. There is also a Welsh language ap called '*Cyw Tiwb*' which is full of Welsh language programmes for children.

**Please note: There WILL be a family quiz as usual on Wednesday evening 27th May.

Q : What are the next steps for schools and Ysgol Gwenffrwd? This is the question on everybody's mind- pupils, parents, staff and Governors alike. We do not have the answer as yet, and therefore we must continue to be patient. This does not mean that nothing is being done- many meetings are taking place and a lot of thinking! As Headteachers within Flintshire, we put in a request (to FCC&WG) to have some time back at school with our Year 6 pupils before the Summer holidays- because we feel that they need time to deal with their next important step in their lives- the transition to secondary schools. NO decision has been made by Welsh Government yet. We are also beginning to work on H&S issues in relation to social distancing regulations and Risk Assessments in our individual school settings etc. There are many, many scenarios to consider. When we have any concrete directives from Welsh Government and FCC- I (on behalf of Ysgol Gwenffrwd's Governing Body) will inform you, as parents/ guardians, of Gwenffrwd's plan of action.
